District ISO Rating

What is the Pagosa ISO rate and Who can receive it:

The Pagosa Fire Protection District (PFPD) has worked very diligently to offer residents professional fire protection and the opportunity of having a quality Insurance Service Office (ISO) rating. Currently Station 7 has been rated by ISO as a Class 6/10. By the guidelines and standards used by ISO standards, this rating will benefit ALL residents who live within 5-driving miles from PFPD fire station 7.

To achieve this remarkable rating PFPD was audited by ISO in multiple ways:

First, the fire department had to prove its capability of fighting fires if a fire hydrant was available within 1,000' of a structure. Second, the fire department had to shuttle water to properties located beyond 1,000' of a fire hydrant. This was accomplished by using a network of water-hauling tankers. The measurable flow rate proved to be comparable of a normal fire hydrant flow.

Both tests were independently audited by ISO and both received an ISO Class 6/10 Rating.

Special Points of Interest

- Properties located within 5-road miles of a fire station are eligible to receive and ISO Rating of Class 6.
- Properties located beyond 5-road miles of a fire station are rated by ISO as a Class 10.

How to find the distance from a fire station to a residence?

- Go to the website of:
 - www.mapquest.com
- Then put in the closest fire station address.
 - Next put in the resident address
 - The road mileage must equal less than 5.1 road miles from a fire station to a resident to receive the Class 6 ISO rating.
